1. **Prof. Raúl Andrade and Prof. Guruprasad Aithal**, chairs of the EASL DHILI Consortium were presenting and coordinating the meeting.
- **Dr. Marina Villanueva** presented the educational activities.
  - Dr. Helena Glasova proposed to invite patients to these kind of meetings, both to learn and to tell their experience. They are already at congresses such as ELPA European Liver Patient Association
- **Prof. Michel Kranendonk** presented the awareness activities:
  - He talked about the dissemination at EUROTOX in addition to EASL.
  - Proposal for a symposium or workshop focused on D(H)ILI in both EASL and EUROTOX.
  - Rolling Program CEC (Continuous Education Courses) of EUROTOX, proposal for 2026, with expert lectures.
  - Prof. Maribel Lucena asked how people could attend these webinars -> Facilitate the exchange of ideas.
  - Prof. Lucena also wondered if reaching to other clinical and pharmacological societies, such as the British Society of Pharmacology.
    - Prof. Ann Daly answered that it is not a good option, but with the EACPT we could be more successful.
    - Prof. Gerd Kullak is going to present that on Sunday.



- Prof. Kranendonk suggested the Microsome and Drug Oxidations (MDO), but Dr. Ann Daly said it is late for this year, but we could try to go to Hong Kong next event in. two years (but difficult).
- **Ms. Aurélie Papineau** presented the dissemination activities:
  - Sharing any relevant Info in DHILI through all social media (all news should be redirected to her to disseminate them).
  - Press releases in media of important advancements and publications.
  - Collaborations with different associations, as EASL, AASLD SIG Seminars.
  - Publication of a newsletter every three months (Prof. Cubero)
  - Educational activities, such as the monthly seminars, the EASL studio and the meetings of this consortium.
  - Proposal to have our 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting within the AASLD LIVER MEETING 2024 @San Diego 15-19 November.

- Aurélie commented that the EASL Centers of Excellence initiative is on hold until further notice (no budget)
- Collaborative proposals within the consortium:
